Mary Cariola Children's Center School reviews its policies and procedures annually and as needed to ensure the safety of everyone in our buildings. This guide outlines current plans.

GENERAL SCHOOL SAFETY

1. Visitor Control: Visitors are allowed entry by a visual/buzzer system.
2. School personnel wear photo ID
3. All exits require entry via fob.
4. Video Surveillance Cameras.
3. Local and County Wide Communication with 911 system as well as first responders are in place between critical school personnel.
4. Emergency notification communication systems via School Messenger.
5. Safety plan and procedures follow FEMA and National Incident Management guidelines.

Standard FEMA Training and Preparation for Responses:

1. Shelter In Place
2. Hold In Place
3. Evacuation
4. Lock-Out
5. Lock-Down
6. Missing Child
7. Bomb Threat

EMERGENCY RESPONSE RESOURCES

1. Go Bags complete with supplies needed to respond to an emergency located in every building.
2. Classroom emergency bags loaded with supplies specific to each individual room.
3. School wide emergency cell phones in the hands of nurses, behavior therapist, supervisors and other emergency responders.

EDUCATION & TRAINING

Developmentally and age appropriate lessons and Social Stories delivered to students.

FEMA courses for individuals in leadership positions.

Basic response training for all staff within 30 days of hire and annually thereafter.

Drills and exercises such as evacuation and lock-down for all students and school personnel conducted monthly.

Campus Specific Response Training for Supervisors, Principals, Vice Principals and other individual conducted quarterly.

MITIGATION

Safety Walk-Throughs are conducted in classrooms, therapeutic and common areas on a regular schedule by trained, objective observers.
